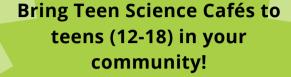


Do you serve teens (12-18) underrepresented in STEM careers?

What is the format of a Teen Science Café?

Cafés are typically an hour and a half once per month during the school year. During a teen science café session, teens socialize over teen-friendly food and drink, have a lively conversation with a local scientist and/or engineer about current cutting-edge developments in their fields, and participate in a hands-on activity related to the scientist and/engineer. Cafés can take place within an after school program, library, community center, community college, museum, or any indoor or outdoor space where the public gathers.

HOW TEENS BUILD AN ENGINEERING MINDSET

- Solve real-world problems
- Envision multiple solutions
- Balance criteria and constraints
- Explore materials
- Apply math and science
- Persist and learn from failure
- Evaluate and iterate
- Work in scientists and engineers

WHAT THE DATA SAYS

- Teens who attend multiple café reported significantly greater levels of STEM Engagement and Identity
- Teen Leaders reported significantly higher levels of STEM career knowledge over time.
- 100% of adult leaders felt more comfortable, confident, and capable of leading STEM through their participation in TSC.

- Six one-on-one mentor check-ins with TSC staff before and/or after cafés



- May: Disseminate student survey to teens at the conclusion of the final TSC
- May: Complete **educator survey** at the conclusion of the final TSC

Jan. - June 2024

- TSCN summer workshop mid-June travel provided by MGM and food and lodging provided by TSCN
- Receive final installment of stipend funds, if qualified
- 2 participants and 2 TSCN staff attend Girls Build Solutions
